

"Charlie "Jolly" Rogers, recently deceased, was married to Rosemary "Roz" Rogers, MSJ '62 and lived a selfless life to benefit all those he met. Raised in Proctor where he was a star athlete, he and Roz were an inspiration to all. When their son Matt entered MSJ in 1990, among the fundraising activities that Roz and Jolly participated in led to their idea of involving local restaurants in a dinner served at the academy. Thus began the Taste of Rutland, an instant success held annually at MSJ. Dr. Robert O'Brien excelled at Mount Saint Joseph Academy in the classroom and was a captain of the school's ski team in the late 1940's which was the early years of ski racing and competed against the Mead family members from crosstown Rutland High.

Robert went on to St. Michael's College and the University of Vermont Medical School before joining the United States Navy for 25 years of services that began with saving lives in Vietnam to Captain and Commanding Officer in Naples, Italy for which he was responsible for the medical well-being of all Navy service members in the Mediterranean region of Europe.

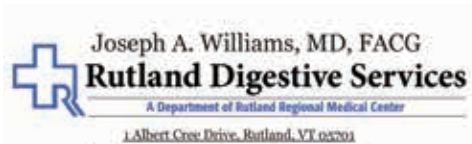
